

The Zippers hail from a long and honorable American Tradition. One that was forged in the foothills, mountains and rivers of Southwestern Pennsylvania. Hard work and hard play, brotherly love, strength and loyalty are the qualities that make-up the people in that blue collar world of coal and steel.

Rising from this mix of the ethnically diverse, hardworking people of the mills and mines came a tenacious, no frills heartland rock band - The Zippers. They tore up the club circuit in and around greater Pittsburgh for much of a decade during the early '80s to the early '90s. They took their power pop, rock and roll nationwide with the release of their self-titled MCA/Gold Dust debut album in 1990.

"We're a blue-collar band with a progressive twist", says lead singer/songwriter/guitarist Terry Callahan. Terry led The Zippers though the twists-and-turns that are part of an artist's rise towards the long awaited record deal.

The Zippers have performed hundreds of shows on the Eastern seaboard. Their incendiary live performances are driven by: Terry Callahan on guitar and vocals; Vinny Q on guitar and vocals; Gary Barnhart on bass and vocals; and Johnny "Day" Dodato on drums.

Once again, The Zippers are poised to showcase their firebrand of melodic rock and roll internationally with their re-mastered, self-titled album that is being re-released on Angel Air Records of the UK. Release date for the UK is March 9, 2018 and in the US on March 18, 2018.
